In the state of North Carolina, all new teachers with less than three years or teaching experience are required to participate in the BTSP for three years.

NCDPI- North Carolina Department of Public Instruction Licensure Section will issue you an initial license to teach in your area of licensure.










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You will participate in an BT Orientation with your district and school to review requirements and expectations.
