ECU will work to review your transcript(s) at the time that you reach 24 hours of content to enroll you into our Residency Program. ECU will accept grades of C or higher on coursework to determine meeting the 24 hour content requirement.

Please use the titles of the above courses as Key Words in your search for appropriate content courses. If you find any at our institution, the Office of Alternative Licensure can assist you with registration upon your admission to the university as a Visiting Student. Visiting students are not eligible for financial aid as you are not seeking a license and affiliated with our Residency Program. You would be classified as a Visiting Student until you are eligible to be a part of the Residency program and working towards licensure through our institution.
