If you find any at our institution, the Office of Alternative Licensure can assist you with registration upon your admission to the university as a Visiting Student. Visiting students are not eligible for financial aid as you are not seeking a license and affiliated with our Residency Program. You would be classified as a Visiting Student until you are eligible to be a part of the Residency program and working towards licensure through our institution.
