# I4 SAMPLE SURVEY SCHOOL SURVEY

Welcome to the Comprehensive Assessment of Leadership for Learning (CALL) survey. This is a sample survey for i4 grant participants. The i4 CALL survey will inquire about leadership practices in your school that are not confined to the school principal. When considering responses, please think about the actual work in the school rather than any particular individual.

## Things to think about when taking the survey:

1. Because the i4 CALL survey is measuring leadership practice and NOT necessarily the individual principal, it is important to think about the various practices that occur in the school. When the survey asks about the work of "school leaders," that could be the principal, assistant principals, other formal school leaders, or other informal school leaders.
2. Also, you will notice that most of the i4CALL survey questions have response options that describe different types of potential leadership practices in a school. Please choose the response that best reflects the practice in your school.
3. This is a sample survey, and the resulting data will not be collected or used for any purpose.

## Getting started:

You are eligible to take the full i4 CALL survey if you are an administrator, teacher, instructional support staff, or student support staff.

Logging into the survey:

To begin taking the survey please go to <https://app.leadershipforlearning.org/> and click the "Log in" button on the upper right side of the page. When prompted, please use enter the school code in the box below. Or simply click "Click Here" in the box below:

Please note that the system will then ask for your email address only to send you a link to your individual survey so you can return if you exit before finishing. Your email will not be shared nor will it used to identify you as a user.
