
Sunstorm

A sunstorm is a geomagnetic storm (solar storm), a temporary disturbance caused by solar wind shock wave. The solar wind's magnetic field interacts with the Earth's magnetic field and transfers an increased energy into the magnetosphere. Popularly, a sunstorm is a dramatic rain and wind storm that happens as the sun is still shining. Much like a tornado's violence of wind and downpour and followed quite quickly by shining sun.
